#### October 17, 2024 Zia Board of Directors Meeting Minutes

The October 17, 2024 BOD meeting was called to order at 7:01 p.m. at the Bear Canyon Senior Center, with Club President Pat Mileshosky presiding. A quorum of the BOD was achieved with 15 out of 21 members in attendance.

#### **Item I - Approval of Agenda and Minutes**

The meeting Agenda was approved without changes.

The August meeting Minutes were approved without changes.

#### Item II - Treasurer's report

Sharon Foreman gave the Treasurer's Report. Sharon reviewed the Statement of Activity (SoA) from last month, Quarterly SoA for the first three quarters of 2024, and the Statement of Financial Position. The Treasurer's Report was approved.

#### **Item III Legislative Action Committee Report**

Nate informed the BOD of various news items including the Governor rescinding the Public Safety Emergency Order.

#### **Item IV - Old Business**

Nate Eskey gave the initial report of the Annual Nomination Committee. All current board members are running to retain their positions except Joel Martin, who is not going to run for the Junior Activity Chair after many years in that position. Derek Tucker and Toma Shaver desire the position, and both made a presentation to the BOD. A motion was made to nominate both Derek and Toma to the Annual Ballot and let the membership decide at either the Annual Meeting or via mail-in ballot. The motion was seconded and passed. Each candidate agreed to submit a short bio and platform statement for inclusion in the Newsletter.

Heidi Chowning asked for some additional funds to compensate the NRA Range Officer Trainer for having extra students in class. A motion was made to allow up to \$500 for this, seconded and passed.

Sharon Foreman led additional discussion on the Club obtaining an AED for the range based on recommendations of the Trauma First Aid instructor. More information will be gathered to have an actionable decision in November.

Then Heidi discussed the Action Shooting Clinic. The size was held to 20 for safety and it filled up in 2 days. Concern for attendees without guns or gear requesting \$500 to cover ammunition. A motion was made, seconded and passed.

#### Item V - New Business

Chris Garrett led a discussion about options for getting people for the New Member Orientation team. After some discussion, the best approach was to put out a notice in an email blast.

Gary Wells invited some Veteran's Air Gun participants up to address the BOD. They presented Zia with a very nice certificate of appreciation.

Gary also discussed his successful effort to create a new shooting group: The NM Air Gun League. It is already off the ground and intends to offer fun competition for all ages and skill levels. Categories are based on performance not age or gender. Their first match is scheduled to be held at Eldorado High in November and Gary asked the Club for help to pay for medals and trophies. A motion was made for \$630, seconded and passed.

Pat Mileshosky discussed the condition of the roads on the range: from thanking the Operating Engineers to the deep sugar sand at the main turnoff to the West Range. We discussed options to mitigate the sugar sand.

Pat also discussed the need for more repairs and improvements to the Range House, including replacing the roof, repairing the exhaust fan, and installing some parking bumpers. We will hear more about this in the upcoming months as Pat completes research and gets some actionable information


#### Item VI - Adjourn

If you could get a shooting lesson from anyone, who would it be and why?


I would like a shooting lesson from Jerry Miculek because he is a super all around shooter.




