December 19, 2024 Zia Board of Directors Meeting Minutes

The December 19, 2024 BOD meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. at the Bear Canyon Senior Center, with Club President Pat Mileschosky presiding. A quorum of the BOD was achieved with 17 out of 21 members in attendance.

Item I - Approval of Agenda and Minutes

The meeting Agenda was approved with three additions (Nate member concern, Ron senior center, and Josh 3-gun request). The November meeting Minutes were approved without changes.

Item II - Treasurer's report

Sharon Foreman gave the Treasurer's Report. Sharon reviewed the Statement of Activity (SoA) from last month. Sharon also asked the Activity chairs in attendance about their respective 2025 Activity budget baselines. The Treasurer's Report was approved.

Item III Legislative Action Committee Report

Nate reported that he will cover the 60-day session as he did last year. Nate suggested a higher level of engagement from the membership would be a good idea perhaps attending a rally in Santa Fe. The slate of bills this year look similar to prior years with the legislature planning to focus on limiting the 2A rights of 18-20 year-olds. Nate volunteered to help look for a Club Attorney.

Item IV - Old Business

The AED topic was deferred to January as Heidi was unable to attend.

Item V - New Business

- Vic Echeverria discussed the need for Action Handgun to get a new main shed. Multiple options were discussed, and this topic will be revisited in upcoming meetings.
- Pat Mileschosky presented an idea to give Joe Benevidez a one-year Honorary membership. Joe runs the Operating Engineers and recently repaired our roads for a very reasonable cost. A motion was made, seconded, and passed.
- We had a disciplinary hearing for a member who broke Club rules by using the range for commercial purposes (teaching CCW classes). This member was told in March both verbally and via registered mail that such activities are prohibited by Club rules (including references to the specific rules in both the Club ByLaws and Member Guidebook). We found out this person continued to use the range for his business after the March communications. After hearing from the member and discussing his lack of remorse, a motion was made to dismiss him from the Club, it was seconded and passed.
- Pat also discussed the ideas of having more board oversight into Junior shooter sponsorships (helping with travel expenses) and instituting a two-deep leadership policy. Both ideas were well received by the room and this topic will come up again as progress gets made.
- Nate's member concern was about an issue we had at the gate between a non-member and a member that went sideways. The non-member in question was in attendance and engaged the room in a lively discussion. At the end of the discussion, it was determined that the non-member would be allowed to join Zia with the conditions that he take down online comments and apologize to the member for his behavior (and the member would likewise apologize for his behavior). Other corrective actions to take include effectively communicating proper gate etiquette with both non-members and members.
- Josh as proxy for Ross asked the board for \$3000 for the 3-gun activity to purchase targets (stands, steel, hit indicators, etc.) A motion was made to fund the request, seconded, and passed

Item VI - Adjourn

After discussing or deferring all the items on the agenda, the meeting was adjourned at 8:20 p.m. Next month is the Annual Meeting to be held on January 16, 2025 starting at 7:00 p.m. at Glory Christian Fellowship Church, 2421 Wyoming, NE.



For some of you, it is almost time to renew your Zia membership. How will you know when it is time for you to renew? Check your membership card. The expiration date for your current membership is written on the card. Hint: If you joined in the last year, your expiration date is a year from when you joined.

Online Renewals

You will receive renewal reminder emails 30, 15 and 7 days before your membership expires. If you do not renew by the expiration date, you will have a thirty day grace period, after which time, a \$35 late fee will be added to your dues and your gate key will be deactivated. Once you have paid your dues, plus the late fee, your membership will be reinstated and your gate key reactivated.

The Process

The reminder emails will contain renewal instructions and all the links needed to take the annual test, and log into your account. You and your Associates need to take the annual test, make sure your NRA is up to date, and update your profile page. Check your profile page, and make any changes as necessary (i.e. update NRA expiration date, annual test codes, change of address, phone number, email, etc.) Once you have done that, and paid your dues, new membership card(s) will be mailed to you, your Associates and Juniors.

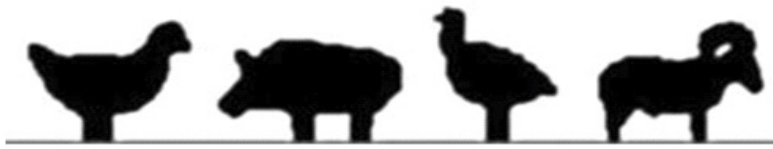
If you need to change your membership, i.e. add or remove an Associate, update to Senior membership, etc., put in a ticket, explaining the change, and we will update your membership and send a new invoice.

Please note: if you are adding a new Associate, they must take the annual test, separate from you, and enter their code into your profile. They must also attend a New Member Orientation (NMO) class. Once they have been added to your package, they will automatically be added to the NMO list and invited to the next orientation class. Once they have completed the class, they will receive their gate key and membership card.

Mail In Renewals

For those few members, you will receive your renewal form and annual test in the mail. Fill both out and mail them in. As stated above, if you have an Associate (or wish to add one), they must submit an annual test, separate from yours. And, if they are new Associates, they must also attend the New Member Orientation class.

Happy New Year everyone. What a year we had in 2024! The February 2024 match blessed us with 33 competitors and made us realize that physical as well as administrative changes needed to be made for us to continue to accommodate the interest and commitment of the Small-Bore Rifle Silhouette community at Zia. Therefore, we requested funds from the Board of Directors on February 15th and by Monday February 19th all the physical renovations had been completed that transformed the Small-Bore Rifle Silhouette range into what it is today. We now have racks for 40 rifles, 20' of benches for competitors and spectators, equipment shelving, and a paved walkway entrance to the shooting concourse. New targets were acquired and the stands modified to accommodate a different match approach. Subsequent matches throughout the year have proven that the changes were not only necessary but also effective in making the matches run much smoother within a shorter time.

It is my goal to make the Small-Bore Rifle Silhouette matches family friendly yet competitive. We often have potlucks, and we have proven that we can eat as well as we can shoot. Competitors' ages range from 9-year-olds to folks in their 80's. We have structured competition classes so that shooters compete with similarly qualified individuals. 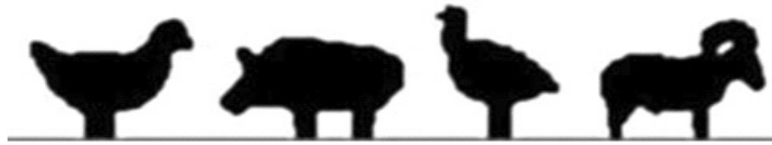

Nothing formal, just structured, because silhouette shooters are always up for a “match”. At the conclusion, Jerry C. had the best score, and me being me, thought that it would be appropriate to provide some sort of award to commemorate the occasion. The only thing that I could find in the way of an award was a broken chicken target that needed repair. Dusting it off, and with as much pomp and circumstance as I could muster, I presented it to Jerry for his accomplishment. It was there on that day that the Broken Chicken match was conceived. So, continuing the tradition, the 2nd Annual Broken Chicken match was held on January 1, 2025. 21 competitors showed up for the event. We started at 12:30 as the match was on a Wednesday and the range wasn't available until after noon. That made for different lighting, but silhouette shooters will find every excuse for not shooting their best. Having said that, aside from the lighting, the weather was great! The wind was not an issue, and it stayed warm throughout the match. For the 2nd year in a row Jerry C. won overall and was again presented with a “broken chicken” trophy. Small Bore Silhouette shooting is one of the most challenging sports for individual marksmanship. Many great shooting competitions offer challenging shots at long range from a bench or other supported position. All our shooting is done from a standing position swaying in whatever breeze there happens to be. We shoot 10 chickens at 40 yards, 10 pigs at 60 yards, 10 turkeys at 77 yards, and 10 rams at 100 yards. A total of 40 rounds are needed for a match plus sight in rounds.

We shoot with .22 rim fire rifles with scopes or open sights. Any standard velocity or high velocity .22 short, long, or long rifle ammo is permitted but the extra hot rounds such as the STINGER or VIPER rounds and magnums are prohibited.

The following is information taken from the NRA Silhouette Rifle Rule book and explains the match time sequencing:

Time is not checked on each shot but is computed on the indicated allowance for each five-shot string. The Range Officer may terminate any relay before completion of the full-time allowance, if all competitors in that relay have completed firing.

Time Allowances:

Ready Time - Fifteen seconds will be allowed after the command **READY** is given before the command **FIRE**.

Two- and one-half minutes will be allowed to fire one shot on each target of a bank of five targets. Targets are shot in sequential order from left to right.

Alibis - 30 seconds will be allowed for each unfired round of the series in which the alibi is allowed.

Shoot-offs - 30 seconds will be allowed for each shot fired in a shoot off of ties.

A minimum of 30 seconds will be allowed between the commands CEASE FIRE and READY.

The small-bore rifle silhouette match is held on the first Sunday of each month.

Setup starts at 8:00am. We will have a sight in/practice period starting after set-up and will start the match promptly at 9:00am.

This event is open to any Zia member/guest, and all are welcome. Juniors are encouraged to try this fun and challenging shooting sport.

The adjacent bench rest/plinking range to the immediate West of the Small-Bore Rifle Silhouette Range will be closed for the duration of our matches. This will allow us to provide participants with a higher level of safety.



You will start to see this sign at some of the scheduled matches starting in November. For safety purposes and as documented in the by laws, Article VIII, Section 2(b) states:

Matches or tournaments will take precedence over other shooting activities at the Range and for safety reasons certain ranges will necessarily be closed during the hours of the match or tournaments.

Every effort will be made to publish range closures in the Club Newsletter and on the web site prior to such a match or tournament. The Range Officer in charge of the match shall have the authority to halt firing on any adjacent ranges which he deems unsafe to the competitors or other shooters.
